
SPEECH DISORDER NEWBORN AND INFANT FEEDING (0-3 YEARS)

BOTTLE FEEDING

If you notice **any of the following situations** with your baby or infant on a regular basis, talk with your doctor, a speech therapist, an infant's nurse or a midwife.

Turning away from the bottle and/or the nipple/pacifier

Skipping feeding



Reluctant to any type of nipple

Drinking very slowly

Refusing to switch from breast to bottle

Unable to latch the bottle's nipple (tongue position, milk dripping)



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
